**Vice Chairman Operations** - Barry Fasbender – American Sports Academy (ASA), is building a \$75M Sports Complex in Reno, Nevada that will have facilities for five sports. Will be done in about 18 months. It includes two Pool Arenas. Pool area #1, will seat 2500. The pool is 60m x 25 Yd with two bulkheads, 4' to 16' deep, bulkhead can be lifted out of pool. Pool area #2, will seat 2500. There are three pools: (1) 25m x 25Yd, 2m deep; (2) 50m x 25 yd pool, 2m deep; (3) Diving pool: 25 Yd x 60 ft, 20 feet deep, 1-2-5-7.5-10 Platforms. There are underwater catwalks with windows. There are 25,000 hotel rooms within a few miles. They will not charge rent – take 10% of admissions. It is at 4200 ft elevation. It will include a 24 sq ft hypodermic room.
