# Registration—O'Brien

- As of February 13, 2015 Pacific has 8,786 Members Registered;141 registered clubs;;
   376 self-identified coaches.
- In mid-February 2014, Pacific had 8,280 Members Registered;130 clubs; 131 selfidentified coaches.
- USMS has 46,319 members registered; 936 clubs; 2,906 self-identified coaches as compared to a total in 2014 of 62,271 members registered; 979 clubs; 3,561 self-identified coaches.
- Paper renewals have been sent to members who do not list an email with their registration and have not renewed for 2015 but were members in 2014.

### Top Ten & Records—O'Brien

- The SCM Top Ten has been submitted to USMS and to the Pacific website.
- Swimmer of the Year tabulation is done. Thanks to Bob Upshaw who spent countless hours making the tabulation accurate. I request a vote to approve the tabulation.
- Franz Mortensen met with me this past weekend to integrate and house our Pacific Records in
  the ActiveHY-tek program so that they are available to all Meet Directors and will be
  consistently accurate and in the proper format for Meet Manager. I am looking into whether the
  records should be updated at the end of each season or by progression throughout each
  season. I am looking into what the policy is for USMS Record keeping and updating.
- Awards for SOTY have been selected and are in the process of purchasing. Sports Basement
  has again generously donated two \$100 gift certificates to the male and female SOTY.

#### Vice-Chairman Administration—Clemmons

> Ad hoc committee on Reserves:

Questions we are trying to respond to are:

- 1. What is the appropriate size of our reserves?
- 2. If we are currently in excess of that level, what should we do to lower our reserves? Rebate to members, buy more equipment, apportion excess amount to clubs and let them buy equipment?
- 3. If we have a consistent surplus, should we consider lowering our dues?

We have approx. \$350k between checking, savings and a CD. Our annual operating costs vary between 205k (2013), 175k (2014) and 282k (2015 budgeted) so we have between approx. 1.25 and 2 years of reserves depending on which number you work with.

The Committee of Teddy Palmer, Charlene O'Brien, Craig Zais, Barry Fasbender and Jim Clemmons corresponded via email a number of times over the past few weeks regarding the subject of Reserves. We have researched and found that a specific amount or ratio of income to reserves that can be maintained is not regulated but more or less dependent on how the funds are provided and how they are expended. We feel the Pacific LMSC has between little and no risk currently with its funding and expenditures strategies.

We will continue to discuss the matter with a goal to have a few different recommendations at the March meeting.

#### New Team/Club announcements in the Pacific Update:

A question came up as to whether or not new clubs should be mentioned in the Update. We specifically had a member request inclusion for a new club he has registered. We would request the PacMasters Committee provide guidance on the following in response to the issue/request:

- 1. Mention of every new club when they register for the first time
- 2. Mention of new clubs only at the request of the club
- 3. No mention of new clubs

#### Communications—Moore/Web Site

The webpage now has a link to a map of Pacific Masters Clubs. This link went live on Wednesday 11 February. The map shows a swimming practice location for a Pacific Masters club. Most are pools but there are two clubs that have open water practices.

The "pin" has a web link to the club. This is so the swimmers can get further information about when Master's practices are and other information. The location of the club is signified by the location of a colored pin. A green pin indicates that drop-in's are welcome; an orange pin says that the swimmer should contact the coach before traveling to the pool and a red pin is "members only." The default pin was red, any other color is at the direction of the club rep.

As of last Wednesday 64 clubs have responded. This will be a great way for members and potential members to see where our clubs are located.

# Important Waiver Requirements!

Any swimmers that do not enter the meet online, must fill out and sign the new USMS waiver form that is attached. Signed Liability Releases, both paper and electronic, must be stored in a manner that allows them to be located and retrieved. They must be retained for a period that is at least as long as your state's statute of limitations for personal injury claims. To meet this requirement, include all signed paper liability releases with the meet results and send to the PacMaster's office.
